

Criteria	Points Awarded
<p><i>GPA</i></p> <p>One point will be awarded for good standing in college with at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA. Extra points will be awarded for any GPA as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 4.0+ = 2 points</li> <li>• 3.5-3.99 = 1.5 points</li> <li>• 3.0-3.49 = 1 point</li> <li>• 2.5-2.99 = 0.5 points</li> </ul>	
<p><i>BL 1411 Anatomy and Physiology 1 (or equivalent)</i></p> <p>One point will be awarded for meeting the minimum requirement of at least a grade of "C" in BL 1411 Anatomy and Physiology I. Extra points will be awarded for any grade above C as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A = 2 Points</li> <li>• A- = 1.75 points</li> <li>• B+ = 1.5 points</li> <li>• B = 1.25 points</li> <li>• B- = 1 point</li> <li>• C+ = 0.75 point</li> </ul>	
<p><i>MT 1304 Algebra with Clinical Applications (or equivalent)</i></p> <p>One point will be awarded for meeting the minimum requirement of at least a grade of "C" in MT 1304 Algebra with Clinical Applications. Extra points will be awarded for any grade above C as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A = 2 points</li> <li>• A- = 1.75 points</li> <li>• B+ = 1.5 points</li> <li>• B = 1.25 points</li> <li>• B- = 1 points</li> <li>• C+ = 0.75 points</li> </ul>	
<p><i>ATI TEAS</i></p> <p>One point will be awarded for meeting the minimum requirement of a comprehensive score of at least 58.7% on the ATI TEAS exam. Extra points will be awarded in each of the categories as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reading score at or above 79.5% = 1 point</li> <li>• Math score at or above 88.2% = 1point</li> <li>• Science score at or above 65.9% = 1 point</li> </ul>	
<p><i>Previous healthcare provider coursework</i></p>	

Quarter point (0.25) will be awarded for an official transcript showing completion of up to three (0.25 points per course) healthcare professional coursework with at least a grade of C or better. Total points 0.75	
One point for awarded for healthcare professional certification. Will need to upload certificate to application.	
<i>Previous community or high school service</i> One point will be awarded for documented consistent, sustained community or high school service of at least one year <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Letter of Recommendation <b>on letterhead required</b> and will be used to verify</li> </ul>	
<i>Previous healthcare/service industry related employment</i> One point will be awarded for employment verification of work in a health-related organization or in service-related employment. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Letter of Recommendation <b>on letterhead required</b> and will be used to verify</li> </ul>	
<b>Qualifying minimum score = 4 points</b> <b>Maximum score = 16.75 points</b>
