YOUR FIRST RATTLER TRADITION

Zaragoza, Spain, was the town where Blessed William Joseph Chaminade, founder of the Society of Mary, took time to reflect on his life. It was a place of new beginnings for him. During his time in Zaragoza, Blessed Chaminade was inspired to form the Society of Mary (Marianists), an order of priests and brothers who eventually founded St. Mary's Institute, the forerunner to St. Mary's University, in 1852. Blessed Chaminade's experience in Zaragoza parallels the reflection and new direction you will experience as you begin your collegiate career. As you make the transition to life at St. Mary's, you will be introduced to the campus, academic programs, faculty members, administrators, and other students and their families. We welcome you as a member of the University community and are happy to discuss questions, concerns or curiosities you might have about the experiences St. Mary's has to offer. This program will acquaint you with the University and our academics, social life and spiritual resources before classes start.

The Characteristics of Marianist Universities articulates the common elements of the Marianist educational philosophy and spirit. These characteristics are:

- Educate for formation in faith
- Provide an integral quality education
- Educate in the family spirit
- · Educate for service, justice and peace, and integrity of creation
- Educate for adaptation and change

These approaches to education permeate the St. Mary's experience, from course work to extracurricular events. Zaragoza is designed with these characteristics in mind.
